In pursuance of the directives issued by the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), and in accordance with the schedule declared for Central and State Counselling, the Competent Authority has decided to commence the process of Registration and Counselling (CAP Round 1) for BAMS/BHMS/BUMS Courses (Group B) as per the schedule given below.

The above schedule is subject change as per the direction of various authorities like MCC / AACCC / Central Government / State Government / Hon'ble Court.

Important Information:

- 1) Registration and submission of preferences shall be carried out strictly as per the schedule notified.

- 2) Candidates are advised to carefully read the information brochure and follow all instructions during registration and choice filling.
- 3) Candidates who have already registered for Group A, need to login and apply for session if they wish to participate in Group B & Group C CAP process. They will not have to pay separate fees for the same.
- 4) Registered candidates must complete document verification within the stipulated time to be part of the Merit List for Group B & Group C
- 5) Candidates who do not apply for the session will not be considered for the CAP process even if they are eligible as per the criteria.
- 6) Candidates should also ascertain her/his eligibility for admission to the various courses before filling up the registration form.
- 7) **Candidates who are eligible for Both Group B & C will be able to apply from singly session. However, candidates who are eligible only for Group C courses will not be allowed to apply for Group B.**
- 8) PWD candidates should have claimed the quota at the time of NEET UG 2026. They should submit Online PWD certificate issued by any one of the authorised boards.
- 9) As per G.R. of General Administration Department ROD-4019/C.R 31/ 16- A, dated 12 February 2019 and Government Resolution no. MED-1018/C.R 37/19/Edu- 2, dated 07th March, 2019. "EWS" means Economically Weaker Section, include persons who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SC, ST, DT-A, NT-B, NT-C, NT-D, OBC (Including SBC) & SEBC.
- 10) Candidates belonging to reservation category must claim so in the application form before submitting the same.
- 11) Any claim for converting from Open/General category to reserved category after submission and payment shall not be entertained.
- 12) NRI candidate should register on [Foreign Candidate Registration Portal](#) before **17/09/2026** for verification of candidate's eligibility. The subsequent schedule will be as above.
- 13) NRI candidates should note that they are eligible only for 15% Institute Quota as per merit.
